Scope

- FBB used for carton production
- Inks and coatings
- Adhesives
- Printing equipment and supplies
- Energy sources
- Transportation and logistics services
- Maintenance and repair services

Additional Sustainability Criteria

We will prioritise suppliers who demonstrate commitment to the following sustainability principles:

- **Sustainable Forest Management:**
 - Minimized deforestation and forest degradation
 - Protection of biodiversity and ecosystem services
 - Respect for indigenous and community rights
- **Reduced Environmental Impact:**
 - Resource efficiency and conservation
 - Minimized greenhouse gas emissions and air pollution
 - Responsible water management and wastewater treatment
 - Reduced waste generation and responsible waste management
- **Social Responsibility:**
 - Fair and safe working conditions
 - Respect for human rights and labour laws
 - Diverse and inclusive workforce

Supplier Selection and Evaluation

We will evaluate potential suppliers based on the following criteria:

- Compliance with this policy and other relevant sustainability standards
- Ability to meet our quality and performance requirements
- Competitive pricing and terms

- Transparency and traceability of supply chains

Collaboration and Engagement

We will collaborate with our suppliers to:

- Share best practices and promote continuous improvement in sustainability performance
- Identify and address sustainability challenges in the supply chain
- Build long-term relationships based on mutual trust and transparency

Monitoring and Reporting

We will monitor our compliance with this policy through regular audits and reviews.

We will also report on our sustainability performance, including progress towards our procurement goals, in our annual sustainability report.
